

The 16 to 19 tuition fund academic year 2021 to 2022

The 16-19 tuition fund is available in 2021-2022 to support to support small group tuition for students aged 16 to 19 in English, maths and other subjects that have been disrupted, including vocational and/or academic learning. Funding is being provided to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English and Maths where students have not passed their GCSEs. Funding is also provided to support vocational courses where learning has been lost. It is for students who:

- have not achieved a grade 4 or 5 in English and/or maths
- Come from an economically disadvantaged background

We will also have regard to the needs of students with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND), particularly where they have experienced additional disruption to learning as a result of their specific needs and disabilities.

We plan to spend the funding in the following ways:

1. Providing tuition for small groups of 5-7 pupils in English and Maths resit. This will be a mixture of face-to-face, blended and online learning. The virtual sessions will be scheduled within the school day and the face to face sessions will take place on Saturdays and during holidays.
2. Providing support in vocational subjects to students fulfilling the above criteria who are in need of support. This will take the form of period 6 and period 7 intervention sessions, as well as Saturday and holiday tuition.
3. Providing support for SEN pupils, particularly those with an ECHP for 121 or small group tuition.
4. Providing small group tuition for academic learning for groups of 5-7 pupils who fulfil the above criteria.
